Suddenly, Lancelot remembered he left his bone by the rock. He raced to find it.

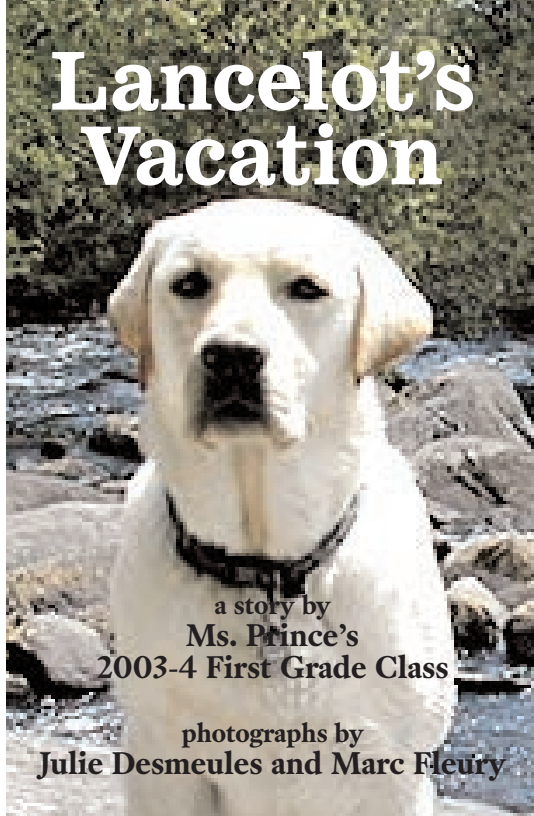


Lancelot swims in the water. He is playing with the stick. He likes to swim.



Lancelot swims two hours every day. He is happy to be on vacation.

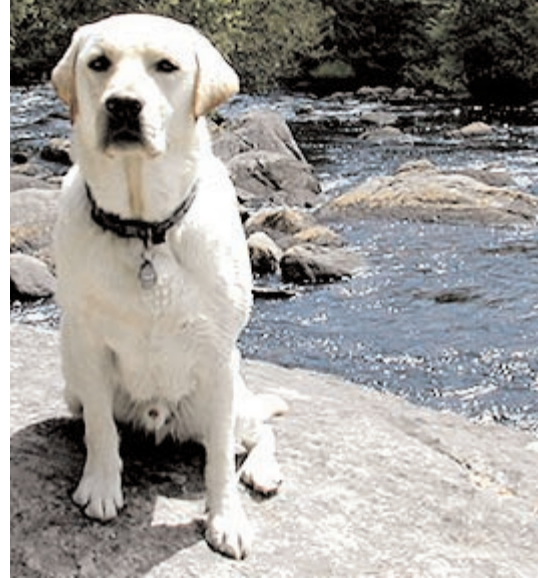
